

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR ENROLLMENT WITHOUT CHARGE
BY SPOUSES AND DEPENDENTS OF CERTAIN DECEASED MILITARY PERSONNEL
AS PROVIDED IN K.S.A. 75-4364 (b)

WHAT BENEFITS ARE AVAILABLE

K.S.A. 75-4364(b) provides an opportunity for spouses and dependents of any **resident of Kansas** who died on or after September 11, 2001, while, and as a result of, serving in military service; and any prisoner of war to enroll at a Kansas educational institution without charge of tuition or fees. **Enrollment without payment of tuition and fees** means that an eligible student will be allowed to enroll without payment of tuition or any mandatory fees required of all students at the time of enrollment. The student will be responsible for other charges associated with the student's academic program and living costs.

WHO IS A DEPENDENT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY

Dependent is defined to include a birth child, adopted child or stepchild OR any child other than the foregoing who was actually dependent in whole or in part on certain military personnel AND who is related to the military personnel by marriage or consanguinity.

Spouse is defined as the spouse of a deceased member of the military service who has not remarried.

WHEN MAY ELIGIBLE STUDENTS ENROLL

Enrollment without charge of tuition or fees will be possible for eligible individuals beginning with the fall of 2005 enrollment period. Each eligible individual may qualify for tuition and fee waiver only for a total of ten semesters of undergraduate instruction or the equivalent thereof.

WHERE MAY ELIGIBLE STUDENTS ENROLL

Enrollment without charge of tuition or fees under this statute will be possible at **Kansas educational institutions** which means public institutions such as: area vocational schools, area vocational-technical schools, community colleges, the municipal university, Regents institutions and technical colleges.
